



# NEW MEMBERS

## A. APPLICATION

### Application - 1

- Complete application form
- Sign and date form
- Two passport photos
- Two references

During this time, applicant should visit range on match day/nights to talk and get to know members and view the shooting activities

Criminal History Check is usually sent by Police to Darwin Pistol Club

### Application - 2

Get a proposer and seconder (must be full members)

### Application - 3

Make application with the NT Police for a Criminal History Check

### Application - 4

Pay appropriate Membership Fee

**On receipt of application documents Membership application to be presented to the Committee for approval**

## B. APPROVAL

Application approved and endorsed at next Committee Meeting

Sport Shooters Permit when attending local Police Station

Applicant needs to bring 100 points of ID

Complete a PF444 - Application for a Sport Shooters Permit

Pay \$10.00

## C. PERMIT

Once Application approved Applicant advised to contact committee member to obtain an approved Certificate of Firearm Club Membership – PF474A

Permit –Category H Sport Shooters Permit Obtain from Committee a – PF474A – “Certificate of Firearm Club Membership” to take to NT Police to obtain Permit

Permit is sent direct to new member and on receipt member needs to make arrangements for Safety/Holster Course

New Member has three months (permit time) to complete Safety/Holster Course

Cat H Sport Shooters Licence when attending local Police Station

Applicant needs to bring 100 points of ID

Complete a PF444 - Application for Cat H Sport Shooters Licence

Supply storage for H class firearms

Supply Record of Participation (only required for re-issued)

Pay \$30.00

## D. CAT “H” CLASS SHOOTERS LICENCE

When completed the Safety/Holster Course the new member can then apply for an H Class Licence and commence competing in sanction matches Member contacts the appropriate committee member to obtain an approved Certificate of Firearm Club Membership PF 474B

Category H Sport Shooters Licence Obtain from Committee a – PF474B – “Certificate of Firearm Club Membership” to take to NT Police to obtain Licence which is sent direct to member

Member needs to complete 12 sanction shoots per year per discipline and applies for a PF474B each year to get a H Class Shooters Licence

**Members are required to hold a current affiliation with the following national/international pistol shooting associations: IPSC NT, Pistol NT, IHMSA, SSAA**
